- On November 24, 2015 the Board unanimously approved a motion to change the current AMC Membership Dues Policy from:
 - O I. Dues (eff. 07-11-2005)
 - A. Dues cover January through December.
 - B. A single membership is \$30.00 per year: \$35.00 for a family.
 - C. Those joining after June 30 pay \$15 or \$18.
 - D. Members joining after October 31 who pay for a full year will have dues credited through the end of the following year.

To:

- O Dues (eff. November 24, 2015)
- A. Dues cover January through December.
- B. A single membership is \$40 per year: \$50 for a family.
- C. Those joining or renewing after June 30 pay a prorated half year rate of \$20 or \$25.
- D. Those joining or renewing after August 31 who pay for a full year will have dues credited through the end of the following year
